

ACCOMMODATION INVESTMENTS IN HOSSA

Hossa has emerged in recent years as one of Finland's most interesting destinations for nature-based tourism. The Hossa National Park, established in 2017, has made the area known both domestically and internationally. In 2024, the area was visited by 75,500 tourists.

Hossa tourist services include Hossa Visitor Centre, camping and caravan area with summer shop, hotel Hossa Holiday Center, restaurants, accommodation and program services, reindeer farm visits as well as cottage and holiday apartments.


Locations for future accommodation investments in Hossa are:

DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Hossa's growing tourism needs more quality services, especially in terms of accommodation and program services. Currently, the occupancy rate of accommodation is very high – in the summer, cottages are constantly full of domestic tourists, and in the winter, international groups fill the winter accommodation during the season that lasts from December to April.

In the future the services in
Hossanniemi consist of current
accommodation services in the
area as well as new accommodation
buildings and separate service
building. The hotel and services can
be implemented in the same building.
The service building serves the area's
entrepreneurs, residents and visitors.
